Maritime transport plays a crucial role in inter-island connectivity, especially for remote coastal communities in the Philippines. In these challenging times, the Philippine maritime industry must adapt and keep up with the latest innovations and modern technologies to have an efficient, competitive, environmentally sustainable Philippine Water Transport System.

Discussions with key stakeholders during the MARINA Maritime Industry Development Plan 2019-2028 formulation process revealed that the sector is confronted by a number of challenges, the most significant of which is the declining competitiveness of the maritime industry, which has resulted in the slow growth of investment, employment, revenues and maritime sector's contribution to the Philippine Economy.
